

Malaria

- Malaria is continuously declined in the state in 2020 and 2021, a total of 15 and 13 malaria cases were reported respectively. Malaria cases occurs in plain regions of the state and in few pockets. Incidence of malaria in Uttarakhand state has decreased by 99.11% from 2014 to 2021.
- Out of 13 districts 6 districts i.e. Almora, Bageshwar, Chamoli, Pithoragarh, Rudraprayag and Uttarkashi are Malaria free districts.
- Four Districts i.e. Dehradun, Pauri Garhwal, Tehri Garhwal and Udham Singh Nagar reported zero malaria case in the Year 2021.
- Malaria and dengue are made notifiable disease in the state.
- No Death Due to Malaria has been reported in the state.
- The testing facility through microscopy is made available upto all CHC/PHC. For distant areas bivalent rapid antigen test are also made available.
- Standard treatment protocol is made available in all health facilities and the health care workers are regularly being trained. Adequate treatment for malaria cases is available in all the districts.
- Malaria surveillance is being strengthened by involving private sector through WhatsApp groups and other digital platform for real-time reporting of any suspect of malaria for confirmation and timely treatment.
- The ASHA workers are roped in and continuously being trained to identify malaria suspects, referring them for testing and facilitate in treatment provision.
- The health facilities staff specially technicians in the interstate border and Indo Nepal border are being continuously trained and monitored.
